

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING
PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF
WASHINGTON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AUTHORITY
REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2025 (HUSKY TERMINAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT)

Public notice is hereby given that on September 30, 2025, at 11 a.m., the Washington Economic Development Finance Authority (the “Authority”) of the State of Washington (the “State”) will hold a public hearing at its offices located at 1000 Second Avenue, Suite 2700, Seattle, Washington 98104-1046.

Pursuant to RCW 42.30.030(2), which encourages public agencies to provide for public access to meetings, this public hearing can also be joined via Zoom or telephonically. The public hearing is being held for the purpose of hearing public comment on the proposed issuance by the Authority of one or more series of tax-exempt revenue bonds for qualified dock and wharf facility projects pursuant to section 142(a)(2) of the Code from time to time in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$50,000,000 (the “Bonds”) for the purpose of financing equipment and facility improvements for the Husky Container Terminal located at the Port of Tacoma (collectively, the “Project”).

The Project is located at 1101 Port of Tacoma Rd., Tacoma, WA 98421, and will be owned by the Port of Tacoma and/or The Northwest Seaport Alliance (an operating partnership of the Port of Tacoma and the Port of Seattle).

The principal of and interest on the Bonds will not constitute obligations of the State of Washington or any political subdivision thereof, but shall be special obligations of the Authority payable solely from the revenues provided for in any indenture executed in connection with the Bonds. The public hearing will be conducted in a manner that provides reasonable opportunity for persons with differing views on both the issuance of the Bonds and the financing of the Project to be heard and to present their oral and written comments. Written comments should be delivered by telephone at the public hearing or mailed to the Authority at the address listed below for receipt not later than one (1) business day prior to the hearing. Anyone requiring an accommodation consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act should contact the Authority at the telephone number provided below at least two (2) business days in advance of the hearing.

This notice is posted pursuant to the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and Open Public Meetings Act, Chapter 42.30 R.C.W.
